6th Annual Wisconsin USMC / NRA Basic Rifle Events Looking Like Another Great Success.

This year's events started on June 15 in Beloit, Wisconsin. Last year 430 individuals participated in this event. At the end of one of the two weeks of this program in 2009, 225 individuals have already participated. The next events will be held in August in Sheboygan.

Created in 2004 by NRA Senior Training Counselor Scott Taetsch, and USMC Master Gunnery Sergeant Mike Krueger, both concerned fathers of young Marines, this program is designed to introduce young "Poolees" to the basics of rifle marksmanship while building confidence in the men and women who have committed themselves to defending our great nation and cherished freedoms.

Initially offered in 2004 at the Stone Bank Sportsmen's Club in cooperation with Heritage Shooting and the USMC, it is now offered at the La Crosse Rifle Club, in Wausau at the Duane L. Corbin Shooting Range, Beloit Rifle and Pistol Club and Sheboygan Rifle and Pistol Club. The program is heavily funded by the Wisconsin Friends of NRA.

NRA FIRST Steps - PISTOL October 17th 2009



The FIRST (Firearm Instruction, Responsibility and Safety Training) Steps Program is ideal for the novice shooter. The goal of this program is teach the participant the FUNDAMENTALS of Firearm Safety and Shooting.

FIRST Steps Programs are available for * Pistol, * Rifle, or * Shotgun. We are only offering Pistol in this offering in October.

It provides hands-on orientation to one specific action type of pistol, Revolver (single action or double action) or Semi-Automatic (various action types) in half day format, including a one-hour shooting session on a range.

Since FIRST Steps programs are action type-specific (only one specific action type of firearm is taught), and teach only the most basic shooting skills, they are not complete "courses" in the traditional sense of the word.

The NRA FIRST Steps program does provide a through introduction to firearm safety, handling, and shooting skills for that one specific action type of pistol. These skills require regular practice.

If you are new to firearms and the shooting sports, a FIRST Steps program may be the perfect introduction.

We are offering the Pistol disciplines only on October 17th 2009

Students may use their own firearm and ammunition in the course **only after it has been inspected and cleared for use by the instructors**. If student does not have a firearm, one will be provided with the appropriate ammunition for an additional charge of \$10.00.

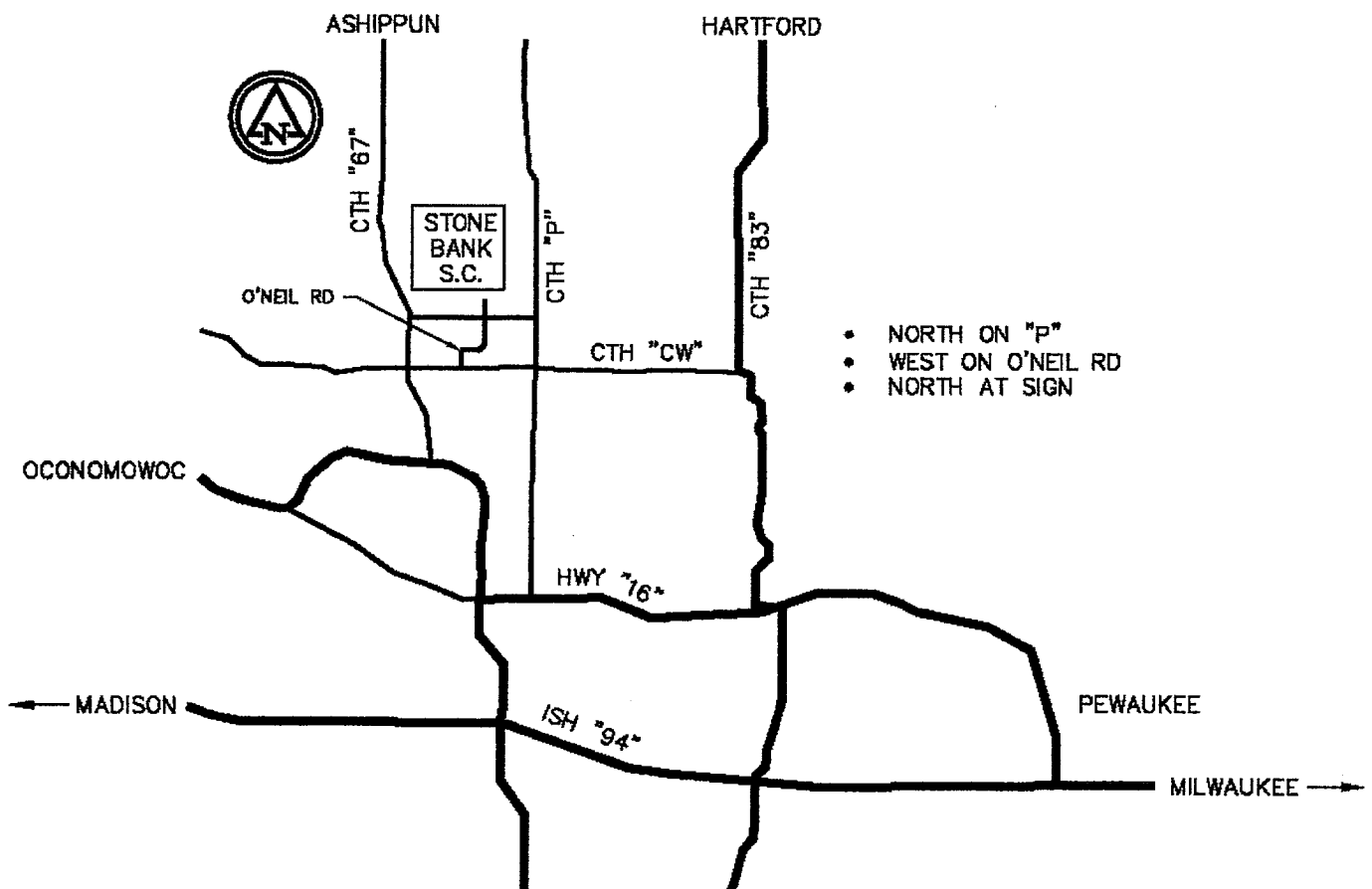
